

Book Study Overview

Book studies are a great way to learn and share with your network members, even if they're thousands of miles away and in another time zone.

If you are interested in doing a book study with your network, ISTE can provide you with both physical and digital copies of any ISTE book. ISTE can provide up to five physical copies and unlimited digital copies of any title for free.

Requesting books

- Contact Simon Helton (shelton@iste.org) and specify the title you're interested.
- Simon will confirm the title's availability in both formats, or when the title will be re-stocked, and how soon he can provide the book copies.
- Send Simon a spreadsheet with the name and shipping address of each person receiving a physical copy of the book (maximum of five).
- Simon will confirm that these orders have been placed, and attach the digital copy of the book for the organizer to share with all participants.

Things to keep in mind

- This process can take multiple weeks if the title is out of stock. Please take this into account when scheduling.
- We send ePub files by default for digital books, but can provide other formats upon request.
- All book study organizers will be asked to share a survey with participants to get feedback on the book.
